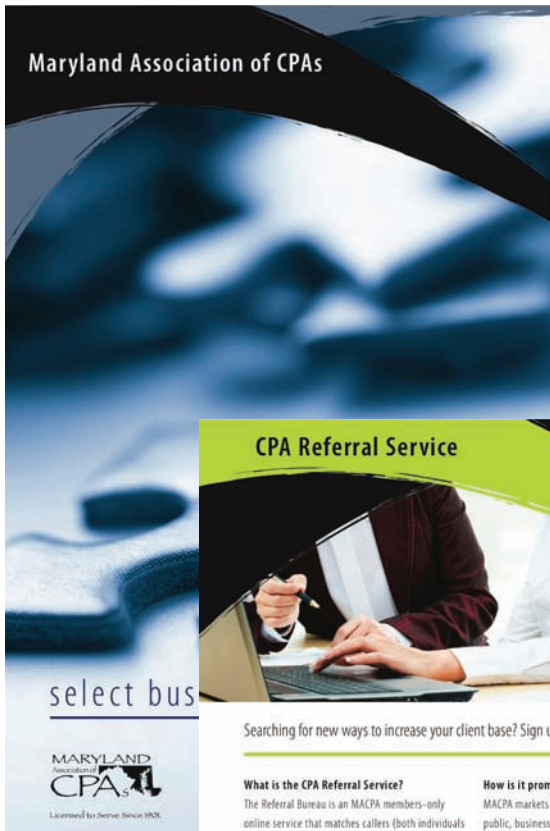

What is the CPA Referral Service?

The Referral Bureau is an MACPA members-only online service that matches callers (both individuals and businesses) looking for CPAs with MACPA members who can provide the services needed. Each year, the bureau generates more than 800 CPA referrals statewide.

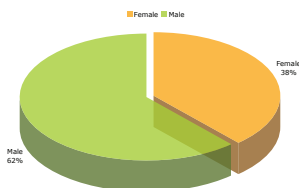
MEMBER DEMOGRAPHICS: Where they live



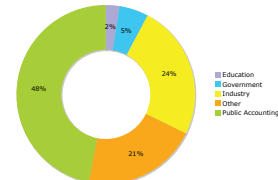
MEMBER DEMOGRAPHICS: How old they are

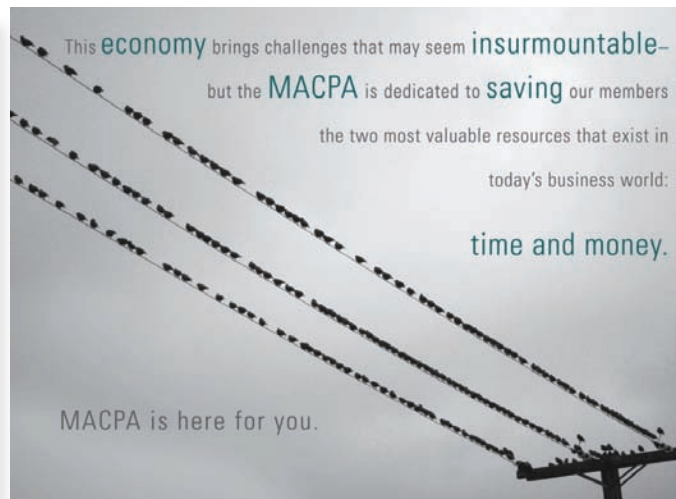
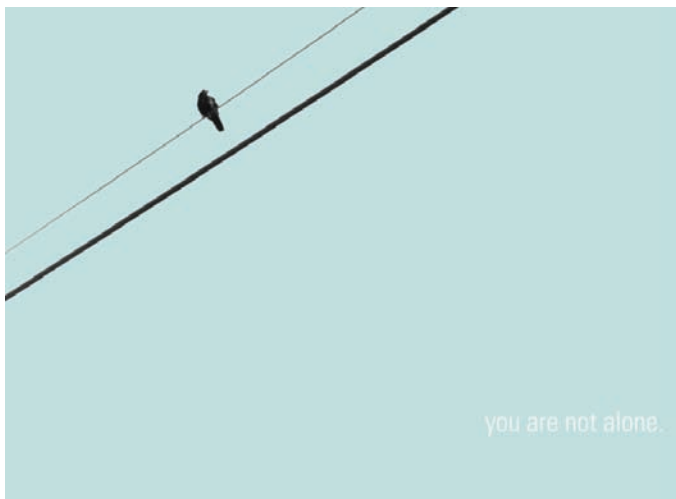


MEMBER DEMOGRAPHICS: Who they are

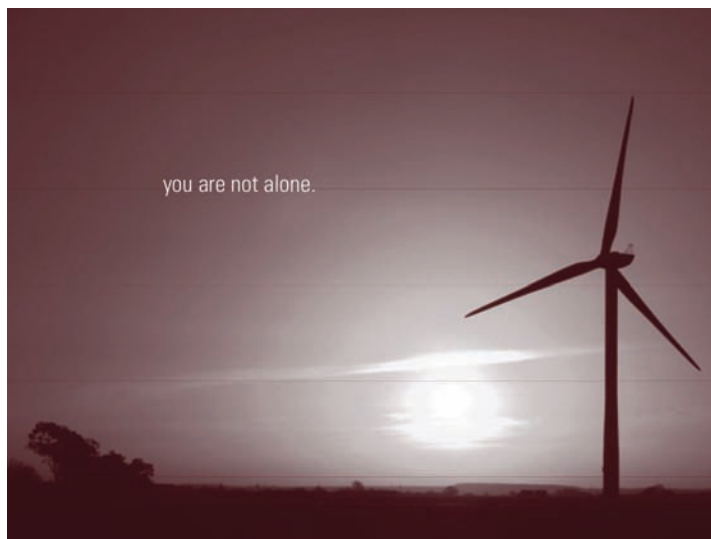
